

As business owners, this is helpful information and keeps everyone on the same page.

- 1. If an employee has been exposed, they need to self-quarantine for 14 days after exposure.
- 2. If an employee has not been exposed and has not traveled, there is no reason for testing.
- 3. If an employee is sick and chooses to self-quarantine, they should not seek medical attention specifically to receive a doctor's note.
- 4. If an employee is sick and feels ill enough that they need to be seen by a provider, please call in advance to schedule a time to be seen. If it can't wait, please report to the Emergency Room. Calling ahead to the emergency room is great too!
