



WOUND CARE FOR BREAST CANCER SURVIVORS

Breast cancer is the most common cancer in women in the United States, apart from skin cancers. Currently, there are more than 4 million breast cancer survivors in the U.S., including patients who are undergoing treatment and those who have completed it.

Breast cancer treatments have continued to improve as a result of research and funding and can include surgery and radiation.

While these treatments are often successful in eliminating the cancer, they can have long-lasting effects months or even years after treatment has concluded, such as:

- + Non-healing surgical wounds
- + Compromised skin grafts or surgical flaps
- + Wounds associated with radiation
