It is the distinct pleasure of the Minden Medical Clinic to provide medical care to patients in the City of Minden, Kearney County, and the surrounding communities. Based upon the current COVID-19 pandemic and the recent surge in our area, it is the opinion of medical providers at KCHS (as well as the CDC, Two Rivers Public Health Department, and Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services), that masks should be worn during all times while indoors (excluding inside your own house).
